**Microsoft Stream for sharing recorded videos with students in their course.**



### What is Microsoft (MS) Stream?

Microsoft (MS) Stream is an enterprise video service where Three Rivers employees can upload, view, organize and share videos securely with students and each other.

#### Log into Microsoft Stream

Students use a separate Office 365 account from TRC faculty and staff. In order for students to see your videos on Stream, you must log in with a [staff-username@mymail.trcc.edu](mailto:staff-username@mymail.trcc.edu) account in order for students to view recordings you upload.

**USERNAME:**

- Example Employee: Rocky Raider
- Example Username: [staff-rraider@mymail.trcc.edu](mailto:staff-rraider@mymail.trcc.edu)

**PASSWORD:**

- Submit a ticket to IT at [support.trcc.edu](mailto:support.trcc.edu) or call 573-840-9708 for assistance with setting up a new password for this [staff-username@mymail.trcc.edu](mailto:staff-username@mymail.trcc.edu) account. This password must be different from an existing password you use for security purposes.
- Have a password in mind when you call. Passwords must have at least 12 characters and contain
  - Lowercase characters: a-z
  - Uppercase characters: A-Z
  - Numbers: 0-9
  - Symbols : ! # \$ %

#### Why not use OneDrive for shared recordings?

Recordings that contain audio or video of a student must be protected.

- Microsoft Stream requires a student to first log into their Three Rivers' Office 365 account in order to view a recording.
- Through creating "Groups" and assigning students to a group, faculty can deter students from downloading a recording, making it view-only.

1. Create a group and assign students as members.

2. Upload your first video and assign groups to view-only.

3. Link to Microsoft Stream video in Blackboard.

Organize your videos by creating channels.
